Acacia and cardamom on the nose followed up with fresh figs, apricots, honey, vanilla and biscuits. Mouth filling breadth balanced with filigree mineral structure.

In 1920 when Henri Farge bought from a Normandy General 12 hectares of vines. He grew the grapes to sell to the wine cooperative, his son and grandson, Andre Farge, followed with this tradition. In 1980 the domaine was revitalised under Guy Farge.

Having worked at the cooperative of Tain l'Hermitage, in 2007 Guy decided to vinify the grapes: having completed his oenological studies at the University du Vin de Suze-la-Rousse, he left the cooperative to create his own cellar in the heart of the family estate.

In 2011 the winery was increased by five hectares of vines planted in Cornas and Saint-Péray, which amounts to 17 hectares of vines. With his knowledge and ambitions, Guy Farge realised his life project as the culmination of the path traced by his ancestors, combining his craftsmanship, his passion to produce quality wines respecting the nature and tradition, and taste of sharing and conviviality in a place open to trade

This wine is an explosion of fresh tropical fruit, white flowers and almonds.

The Caggiano winery is based in the town of Taurasi, the heartland of Aglianico, which is the main focus of their production (they were the first ones to produce a Taurasi crus aged Bordeaux – style exclusively in barrels in 1994) Antonio Caggiano, the founder of the winery, has designed one of the most spectacular wineries in Campania in 1990. Today thousands of bottles are laid down in its cellars made of the local 'tufo' stone waiting for the sturdy Aglianico to be ready for you to drink.

Full bodied and well-rounded with a complex structure. Bursting with flavours of dried apricots, pineapple and hints of vanilla and honey that last long on the finish.

Ken Forrester represents the true pioneering spirit of the post-apartheid South African wine industry. Drawing on the examples of top Loire whites, he has used his uniquely placed Chenin vines to maximum effect and has single-handedly led a Chenin Blanc quality revolution.

As a result these wines have achieved iconic status worldwide. At the top end there is the beautifully balanced barrel-fermented Chenin FMC, made from fruit grown at Ken's Stellenbosch vineyard, and the silky fine red The Gypsy, made from low yielding vines. An exciting range of wines from a great winemaker with something to suit every palate and the image of modern South African wine making.

Poached pears and melon, with underlying notes of quince and ginger.

Located in the southern Awatere Valley, sub-region of Marlborough, Yealands Estate is arguably the most ambitious family-owned vineyard enterprise in New Zealand. Few could grasp the breadth of Peter Yealands' vision when he took on the challenge of creating terraced vineyards amongst these rolling foothills in the late 90s, eventually realising Yealands Seaview Vineyard. Whilst the majority of the vineyard is planted with New Zealand's world renowned Sauvignon Blanc vines. Peter was one of the first to plant alternative varieties like Gruner Veltliner and Viognier in Marlborough.

Yealands Estate is a showcase of innovative environmental sustainability. The wines are carefully nurtured from the vine to the bottle with low impact methods, leading-edge green technologies and some very inventive thinking. Yealands carbon neutral winery, built in accordance with the New Zealand Building Council's Green Star Building Certification, was one of a handful in the world to achieve CarboNZero™ certification. Launched in 2008, the winery is also the first to have measured and offset all greenhouse gas emissions since day one. With an absolute commitment to sustainable wine production, Yealands brings together winemaker Tamra Washington and winery owner and founder Peter Yealands, whose vineyard development skills and 'green' wine business vision lead the industry in sustainable premium wine production.

With an enviable position on the highest slopes of the Simonsberg Mountain, ranging from 370 to 640 metres above sea level on mainly south-facing slopes, lies Thelema, one of the highest, coolest and certainly most sought-after wineries in the Cape. Gyles Webb, is the heartbeat of Thelema, enviably nestled in one of the most beautiful places in the world to grow grapes. Saved from a certain life of boredom in accountancy by deciding to put down roots on the mountain and produce great wine, Gyles is now ably assisted by Rudi Schultz in winemaking and his son Thomas in all export markets, enabling him to go back to the vineyard and concentrate on the improvement of soil health and diversity in order to grow the best grapes to make the finest wines. The winemaking is as natural as possible with minimal handling – a policy which they charmingly describe as 'benign neglect', and the vision for the Thelema wines is just as down to earth; Gyles has regularly been heard saying that all they to do is make honest wines which people will enjoy! True to this vision, Gyles and Thomas can regularly be found enjoying good wine and great food themselves in some of the UK's best restaurants.

*San Antonio*  
Complex and elegant, with aromas of strawberry, cherry, orange peel and herbs, which combines with oak.

The Leyda Valley lies to the west of Santiago, just 14km from the Pacific, and its closeness to the sea ensures wonderfully cooling summer breezes which whip across the vineyard from 10.00am each day, moderating temperatures and cleansing the vineyard. In 1997 the Fernandez family, together with Gustavo Llona, recognised the potential of the area for growing grapes and established Vina Leyda. In the course of building an eight kilometre pipeline from the Maipo River for irrigation, crucial research suggested that the cool but sunny climate would suit Pinot, Sauvignon and Chardonnay and planting took place, with the first harvest in 2001. Now with 216 hectares under vine, the Pinot Noir Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay are all thriving, and with Merlot on the way, the future for Vina Leyda is very exciting. The Garuma Sauvignon Blanc won the top 'Best White Value Whites' trophy at the Wines of Chile awards 2011, one of five trophies for the winery.

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128. 2013 **Gigondas Tradition, le Grand Montmirail, Domaine Brusset** 54.00

Lush but bright in the mouth, with noteworthy depth of flavour and restrained sweetness.

This 85 hectare estate in the heart of the Southern Rhône was founded by André Brusset in 1947 and includes vineyards in Cairanne, Gigondas and Côtes du Ventoux. The domain is now run by grandson Laurent, who focuses on excellent quality fruit, vinified in a traditional manner, with a small proportion undergoing whole bunch fermentation in order to retain the fruit of the grapes. The wines strongly evoke a 'sense of place', with nuances of sun-baked rocks and aromatic herbs beneath the peppery fruit.

Dry on the palate, yet velvety, harmonious and very persistent at the same time. Very well balanced, with distinct class and style.

"Matteo Ascheri is one of the most amusing, talented and outspoken winemakers in Piedmont and a man who makes a fantastic range of wines from a mixture of local and international grapes. In a region where value-for-money can be hard to come by, Matteo produces wines that deliver flavour, complexity and finesse and affordable prices." Tim Atkin MW, 2007. As with everything Mateo does, his winemaking ethos is clear; it is the expression of the vineyard, the grape and the climate that he is capturing, not his winemaking prowess. It works, and his wines express elegance and refinement that is often overlooked in today's 'instant fix' world.
